Each year, students enroll in seven (7) courses and one study hall per semester. A full-year course is 1 credit, and a one-semester course is 0.5 credit. Additional study halls must be approved by the Head of Upper School and College Counseling.

Freshmen enroll in English, Judaic Studies, History, Mathematics, Science, Foreign Language, Public Speaking one (1) semester, and a Fine Arts or Physical Education elective course one (1) semester.

Sophomores enroll in English, Judaic Studies, History, Mathematics, Science, Foreign Language, and one (1) Fine Arts or Physical Education elective course each semester.

Juniors enroll in English, Judaic Studies, History, Mathematics, Science, and two (2) elective courses each semester. It is advised to take Foreign Language as one of the two electives.

Seniors enroll in English, Judaic Studies, Mathematics, and two (2) other academic courses, from English, History, Mathematics, or Science. Seniors also take two (2) additional courses from any academic area.
